### TRAINING FEE INFORMATION

**FarmReady (FRTC 0096) is available to attend this course.** Primary producers may be eligible to claim reimbursement for 65% of course fees (up to \$1500 per financial year) plus full reimbursement for associated training expenses such as accommodation and meals. Travel expenses may also be reimbursed if the participant travels more than 150km to attend training.

**Cost of Farming & Grazing for Profit training at Narayen Station, is as follows:**

- FULL COURSE FEES, includes training materials and RESOURCES- \$300 per person - PLUS
- PACKAGE 1 - All MEALS & ACCOMMODATION 7 nights at Narayen Station - \$280pp OR
- PACKAGE 2 –MEALS (Morning/Afternoon Tea, Lunch – 7 days) - \$150pp (own accommodation)
