

Boat Mountain Conservation Park

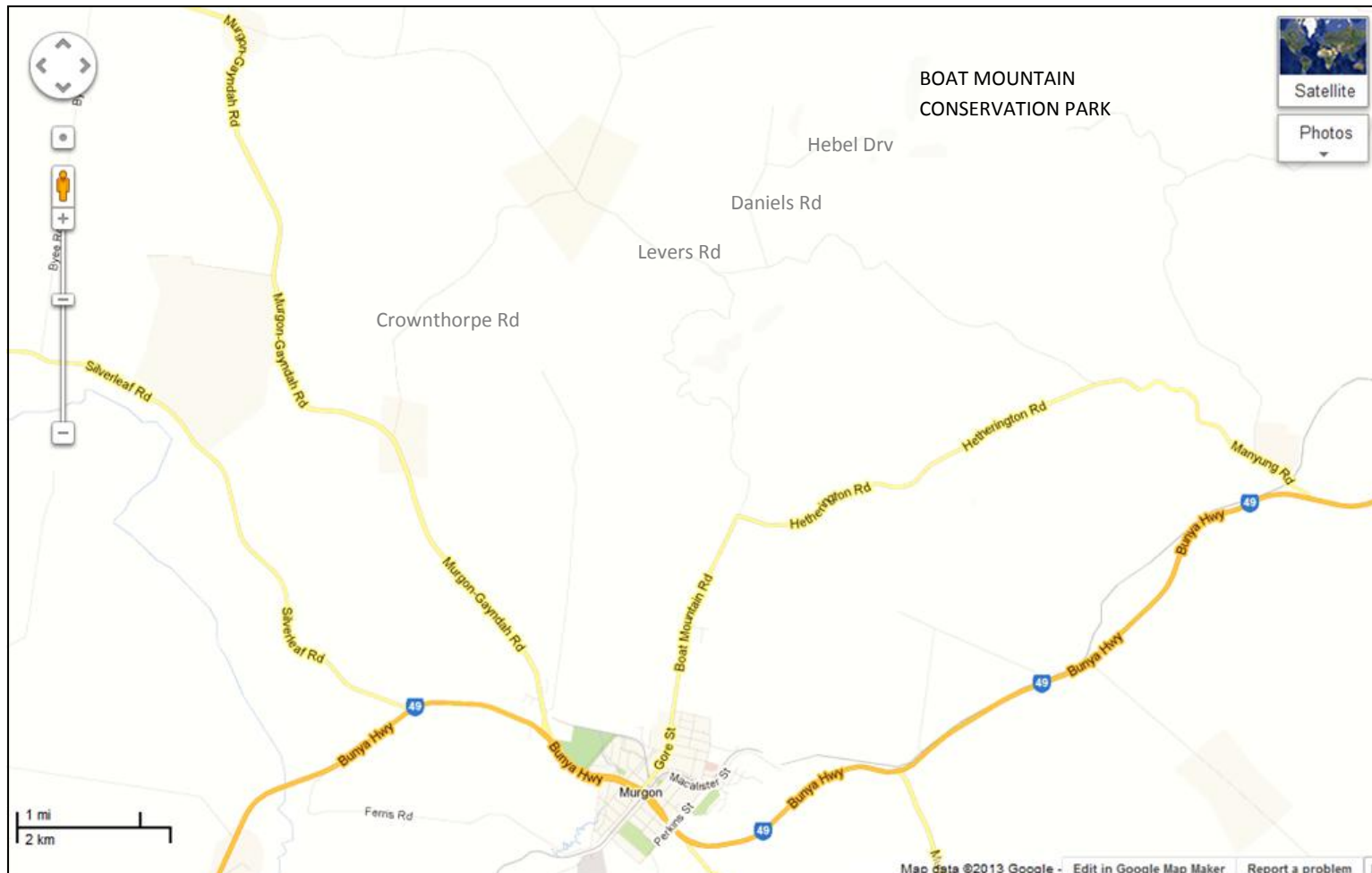
(Boat Mountain Rd north out of Murgon is closed from flood damage)

FROM MURGON:

On **Murgon-Gayndah Rd**, turn RIGHT into **Crownthorpe Rd** (signed for Boat Mountain), then at the top of the hill at the cross-roads at Tablelands turn RIGHT into **Levers Rd**, then LEFT into **Daniels Rd** and finally RIGHT into **Hebels Drv**. Car park is at the end of this road, drive slowly and carefully.

FROM GAYNDAH:

On **Murgon-Gayndah Rd**, turn LEFT into **Crownthorpe Rd** (signed for Boat Mountain), then at the top of the hill at the cross-roads at Tablelands turn RIGHT into **Levers Rd**, then LEFT into **Daniels Rd** and finally RIGHT into **Hebels Drv**. Car park is at the end of this road, drive slowly and carefully.

Road is bitumen all the way, but very narrow near Boat Mountain.

No toilets at the Park, nearest ones are at Tablelands approximately 5km away.

2 walks, both involve stairs. 250m to first lookout and 1.3km to second lookout. BYO picnic chair, hat, water bottle and sturdy shoes.
